## HORTICULTURAL COMPETITION SHOW GUIDELINES

Come share your plants with us!

### **GENERAL RULES:**

1. All entries must conform to the show manual.
2. All entries must be free of disease or insects. Plants that are found to be infected will be disqualified and removed.
3. Exhibitors may submit up to three entries per show.
4. All plants submissions in Division 2 must have been in the exhibitor's possession for at least six months.
5. A plant or entry may be exhibited only once during each calendar year.
6. Plant material should be identified with the correct botanical name(s) and/or commons names whenever possible. Please use "Plant Finder", "Google Lens", "Picture This" apps to help you identify your plants.
7. Entries will NOT be accepted after the regular meeting start time. Late entries will not be judged.
8. All decisions made by the judges are final.
9. Botanical Arts entries will be judged separately and must be placed on the Botanical Arts table. Please identify media used, such as watercolor, acrylics ect.

### **Allocation of points towards annual prize**

1st place= 3 points, 2<sup>nd</sup> place= 2 points, 3<sup>rd</sup> place= 1 point

### **End of Year Prizes for Horticultural Entries:**

1<sup>st</sup> Place: **\$100.**, 2<sup>nd</sup> Place: **\$75.**, 3<sup>rd</sup> Place: **\$50**

### **End of Year Prizes for Botanical Arts Entries:**

**1<sup>st</sup> Prize: \$75**

Section A: Under 6 inches tall

## **Class 2** Arrangements of Purchased/Borrowed Materials

Section A: Under 6 inches tall,

Section B over 6 inches tall

## **Class 3** Dried Floral & Foliage

Section A: Arrangements

Section B: Pressed Flowers

## **Class 4** Mixed Media Arrangements

Can contain flowers, foliage, fruits and other materials

Section A: Under 6 inches tall

Section B: over 6 inches tall

Section C: Tablescapes: Must contain at least 2 pieces from place setting; such as dishes, glassware, tea cups
