Perennials



Helleborus 'Tutu' Adored for her elegant and truly unique flowers that add a regal air to the garden, Tutu Helleborus is truly a work of art. From late winter for months into spring, she features abundant anemone-like, semi-double flowers with pretty purple-pink petals suffused with shades of cream, soft yellow and green. At the center of the cup shaped flowers is a circular mound of delicately ruffled petaloides in shades of pink from which emerge a tuft of creamy yellow stamens. The flowers darken in color as

they age. Exquisite



Armeria Dreameria® is a series of, heat-tolerant, and easy-to-grow perennial sea thrifts (zones 5–9) that bloom continuously from spring to frost, featuring large, globe-shaped, mauve-pink, or white flowers on sturdy 10–12 inch stems. Ideal for containers, rock gardens, and sunny borders, they thrive in full sun and well-drained, even sandy, soils.



Introducing 'Lemon Purrfection' Catmint – the vibrant, citrus-scented addition your garden has been waiting for! This charming perennial combines the refreshing aroma of lemon with the irresistible allure of classic catmint, creating a delightful haven for both humans and felines. Watch as the bees and butterflies dance around its fragrant leaves while also deterring both deer and rabbits. With its striking chartruse foliage and cheerful, lemony scent, 'Lemon

Purrfection' adds a burst of color and personality to any garden. Grows 10-12 inches tall and 16-18 inches wide at maturity.



Allium Glitterbug Humble Bumble® is humble in its height, but boastful in its flower display. Each season begins with the early emergence of fine textured blue foliage. This is attractive in itself, but it gets ever better in summer when the plants are topped with 2-inch wide clusters of purple-pink, balloon-like flowers. Humble Bumble® is a tough little pollinator plant that resists drought and combines beautifully with companions. Grows 15 inches high.

Allium Glitterbug® 'Bee's Knees® Allium Glitterbug 'Bee's Knees' is a wonderful ornamental onion that attracts both butterflies and bees. The violet, pink/purple, sphere shaped flowers are highlighted beautifully by the green foliage. If foliage is broken or disturbed, it will give off an onion fragrance. Grows 16 to 18 inches tall



Anemone Dawn Breaker Breeding breakthrough-blooms spring, summer and fall. Most Windflowers bloom in the fall, but this beauty blooms in late spring into early summer, then again in the fall. It blooms considerably longer than the species. Delicate looking, but extremely tough, its wiry pink flowers flutter in the wind, attracting all with its nectar. Its emerald leaves mature into attractive mounds. Growing only 18" tall makes the plant perfect for smaller gardens, and for the front of the border. It prefers sun to part shade, and will even grow in full shade to full sun.



Heuchera Eternal Flame truly sets the landscape on fire. With fiery red foliage, intense red veins, reddish-pink flower panicles and lime-yellow margins in spring and summer, Eternal Flame sets the scene. When summer ends, the fiery hues of the foliage turn into a bright lime-green spectacle. Its robust, compact structure and sturdy stems make it a low-maintenance addition to any landscape. grows 10 inches high, spread to 16 inches. A bright addition to the shade

Dark Side of the Moon Astilbe An instant classic for the landscape! 'Dark Side of the Moon' is the only dark leafed Astilbe with purple flowers that's on the market. Rich deep chocolate burgundy leaves form an incredibly attractive mound of foliage. Emerging leaves are yellow with a dark margin with a glossy sheen that become completely dark as they age. Dark stems hold raspberry buds that burst forth with rosy purple flowers. This performs best both for growing and flowering in full sun in the north with adequate moisture, but also grows in shade. Perennial plant of the year! Grows 20.0-22.0 high,

Maestro® Coral hummingbird mint Agastache hybrid Designed to make a big splash of color in landscapes and large containers, this long-blooming, low-maintenance hummingbird mint produces a profusion of coral pink flower spikes for months. It begins to bloom early in the season and continues through fall without needing to be sheared back to stay in flower. Maestro® Coral is a pollinator magnet and, true to its common name, hummingbirds find it irresistible. Fortunately, deer don't share the same appetite for this colorful plant. Grows 8 - 18 Inches high, 10 - 18 Inches wide, Proven Winners



Double Coded® Coral Cranberry Coneflower A complementing series of fully double Coneflowers to the single flowered COLOR CODED® collection. Varieties in this series have prolific floral production seated atop dense rosettes of foliage. Broad, horizontal ray petals maximize flower size. Plants are low, wide, and well-branched allowing for use along the front of the border. Enjoy as these perennials burst into life under the heat of midsummer. 'Coral Cranberry' has bright coral pink flowers with wide horizontal ray petals. Butter Pecan has creamy white flowers, Raspberry Beret:
