Supertunia Tiara:



This petunia is praised for its vibrant violet-blue flowers with a white glow, making it a standout in hanging baskets and containers. There is also a pink variety. These are heat tolerant plants, that aren't particularly fussy and need little routine maintenance. They will perform best if an application of controlled release fertilizer is included at the time of planting.

Monarch Magic Ageratum:



This spreading flower attracts butterflies with its abundant blooms, offering a long-lasting display from spring to frost. A one-of-a-kind spreading ageratum that monarch butterflies can't resist. It has a full, spreading look that's ideal for use in baskets and mixes.

Belleconia™ Salmon Begonia

Sun Parasol Bluephoria mandevilla:
